You have been charged with a violation of the Seattle Municipal Code or the Revised Code of Washington. The charge involved is a criminal offense. A conviction can result in a fine or in jail time (up to \$5,000 and/ or 365 days for a gross misdemeanor). The alleged offense(s) requires that you appear in court to answer to the charge(s).

You are hereby ordered to appear at the time and place specified on the reverse side. Failure to appear at the time and place specified may result in a warrant for your arrest, the suspension of your driving privileges or other sanctions allowed by law.

You are presumed innocent until you are either convicted or plead guilty to the charge(s). You have a right to a jury trial. At the hearing specified on the summons on the reverse side, you will be able to discuss your case with a public defender to determine how you wish to respond to the alleged offense(s).

You have a right to be represented by an attorney at this and other court appearances. If you cannot afford to hire your own attorney, an attorney may be appointed to represent you. **If you wish to have an attorney appointed to represent you, you must be interviewed to determine your financial eligibility by the King County Office of the Public Defender.** A representative of the Office of the Public Defender will be present at the hearing and you may be screened for assignment at that time.

It is important that you maintain contact with your attorney. This will allow your attorney sufficient time to prepare your case and may result in fewer, or unnecessary, court appearances for you.
