Counsel:

The above case has been set for oral argument on June 23, 2005, as the 3rd case, and will be held in the Courtroom of the Temple of Justice.

Cases 3 and 4 will be heard in the afternoon session, with Court convening at 1:30 p.m. Counsel should report to the bailiff prior to 8:45 a.m. 1:15 p.m.

Oral argument is currently scheduled to be twenty minutes per side, however, counsel's request for additional time is now under consideration. The Court strongly encourages that, whenever possible, oral argument should be presented by only one-or at most two-counsel per side.

If counsel are aware of any potential amicus curiae, they should be advised RAP 10.2(f), as amended effective September 1, 1999, requires that amicus curiae briefs not requested by the court must be served and received by the court not later than 30 days prior to oral argument.

Metered parking is available in the General Administration parking garage located directly east of the General Administration Building on the Capitol campus; and on the entrance roads to the Capitol campus bracketing the Tivoli Fountain.



Opinions are usually released at 8:00 a.m. on Thursdays. On Wednesdays, a notice will be on the court's homepage, <http://www.courts.wa.gov/home.cfm>, of those opinions that may be released the next morning. E-mail notification of opinion releases is also available by signing up at the court's web site. Once the opinion in this case is released, lead counsel for both parties will be notified by telephone. It will be incumbent upon lead counsel to further notify any other collaborating counsel, to include amicus. Opinions will be mailed the same day, and will be on the court's homepage, <http://www.courts.wa.gov/opinions/recent.cfm>. If a faxed opinion is requested, counsel will be charged \$3 for the first page, and \$2 each following page.
